

# Summer session A Carpathian program



In the period of June 23 – July 3 School of Ukrainian language and culture welcomes the students of its first session to immerse into authentic world of Ukrainian nature and culture in the Carpathian city of Yaremche with its vivid local traditions and customs, picturesque views and unique architecture.

**Kryvorivnya** – one of the most picturesque villages of the Carpathians ("Shadows of Forgotten Ancestors" was filmed here)

**Uzhgorod** – a fascinating city with a grand history

**Kolomyia** – Museum "Pysanka"
